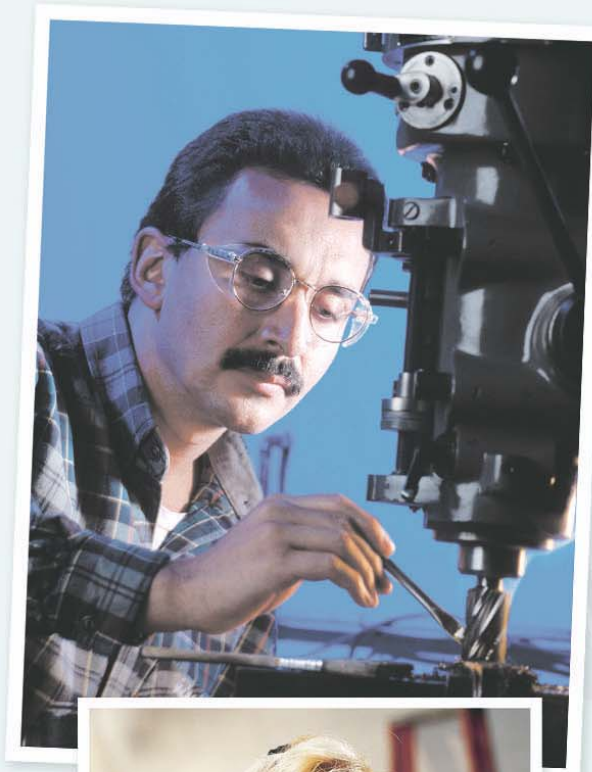

What does OSHA require?

- Employees who wear prescription lenses while engaged in operations that involve eye hazards, must wear eye protection that incorporates the prescription in its design.
- Eye and face protection must be distinctively marked to ANSI Z87.1-2003 Standards.
- Side protection when there is a hazard from flying objects.
- Protective eyewear that does not restrict vision or movement.
